Topic: New York Assigned Risk Private Passenger Penalty Point

AIPSO has announced that the New York State Department of Financial Services has approved clarifications to the Careful Driver Credit rule.

As a result of these changes, penalty point codes 70 and 91 are no longer valid for Private Passenger Assigned Risk data. In addition, penalty point code 00 has been added to indicate 0 penalty points when the careful driver credit is not applicable. There have been no changes to the reporting for Other than Personal Vehicle.

The attached page reflects the new coding. These changes are also reflected in the Assigned Risks Automobile Statistical Plan.
