Topic: JUA Automobile Michigan New Territory Revision

Per statute, the territories for the Michigan Facility shall be defined as those of the principal rating organization for the voluntary market, i.e., ISO. Effective October 2016, ISO has changed their private passenger Michigan territories to be zip code defined. As such, the territory titles have moved from 2 digits to 4 characters and may be a mix of numbers and letters (i.e., 104a). The MI Facility has requested a rate review from AIPSO that incorporates the adoption of these territories.

ISS will collect zip codes with the current rating territory codes instead of adopting the four-digit territory code for Private Passenger data.

The revised rates and territory definitions will have an effective date of 01/01/18.

The changes are reflected in the JUA Personal Vehicles Statistical Plan, see attached page 9.

MANUFACTURER’S MODEL YEAR - PHYSICAL DAMAGE ONLY

Report the actual four digit Manufacturer’s Model Year of the vehicle.

Manufacturer's Model Year is not applicable to Miscellaneous Personal vehicles.

POLICY EFFECTIVE YEAR

Report the four-digit year the policy became effective. For renewals report the effective year of the renewal policy period. For endorsements report the effective year of the endorsement. For cancellations report the effective year of the cancellation.

POLICY TERM

Applicable to Premium records.

Report the number of months the policy is in effect.

DESCRIPTION	CODE
Examples:	
Seven months	07
Twelve months	12

ZIP CODE

Applicable to Michigan and Florida only

Report the five-digit U.S. Postal ZIP Code applicable to the principal place of Garaging. ZIP Code may be reported as zero if the Territory Code is 050.
