Bulletin No. 2020-MH-02

Topic: North Carolina Mobilehome Territory Coding – Revision
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On December 19, 2019, the Commissioner on the behalf of the North Carolina Rate Bureau and the North Carolina Department of Insurance, issued P-19-9 which changed the effective date for implementing the new territories to June 1, 2020.

In addition to the revised effective date, we made changes to the territory list in the statistical plan. The territory code for McDowell County, previously listed as 340, is now correctly listed as 360.

ISS Stat Bulletin 2020-MH-01 has been withdrawn and replaced by 2020-MH-02.

The various revisions are set forth in the following revised pages:

The territory field (positions 40-41) has been expanded to a three-digit field (39-41) in the record format to accommodate these revised territory definitions. The territory codes requiring windstorm deductibles were updated as well.

These changes are applicable to all new and renewal policies becoming effective on or after June 1, 2020.

Rounding, when required, is to be accomplished by adding an absolute \$0.50 to the absolute value of paid loss field and then drop the cents; i.e., a negative \$7.51 would round to a negative \$8.00 and a negative \$7.49 would round to a negative \$7.00.
