Topic: California Low Cost Assigned Risk Automobile Class Coding Revision

To be consistent with industry standards, AIPSO has introduced a new class for the applicant or any driver in the household who is 16 through 18 years of age.

We are establishing a new Classification Code 9610 to identify the Low-Cost Automobile policy data for the new description.

This change applies to New Policies with Effective Dates of February 1, 2018 and Later and Renewal Policies with Effective Dates of April 1, 2018 and Later.

The attached coding on page 43 is reflected in the Assigned Risk Automobile Statistical Plan.
